

EUROPEAN SYMPOSIUM ON SMART CITIES AND ENVIRONMENTAL ACOUSTICS 2014 MURCIA

The European Symposium on Smart Cities and Environmental Acoustics was held on the 30th October 2014 in the Catholic University San Antonio, Murcia, Spain, organized by the Spanish Acoustical Society, the Catholic University San Antonio and the Portuguese Acoustical Society, with the institutional sponsorship of the European Acoustics Association (EAA) and the International Commission for Acoustics (ICA). (*)

The Symposium was a satellite symposium of TECNIACUSTICA 2014 MURCIA that included also the 45th Spanish Congress on Acoustics and the 8th Iberian Congress on Acoustics.

The symposium was developed in two sessions and it was attended by 80 participants.

In the morning session after the official opening, eight invited papers were presented and in the afternoon seven papers. The plenary lecture of the Symposium was dictated by Prof. Luis Muñoz, Dept. of Communications Engineering, Laboratories for R&D on Telecommunications, University of Cantabria.

In the congress opening ICA was represented by Prof. Michael Vorländer, ICA Past-President, and member of the Congress Committee, who presented a power point on ICA members and affiliated societies, a diagram showing that Acoustics is a multi-disciplinary science linked to other sciences, and a short introduction of the International Year of Sound 2019 promoted by ICA.
